We accept and sell the following residential home improvement materials.

<p>Appliances must be five years old or newer and in perfect working condition.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Dishwashers •Washer/Dryer •Water Heaters •Refrigerators •Microwave Ovens •Cook Tops •Ovens (Drop in or free standing) •No appliances green, gold, or brown in color.
<p>Cabinets must have all doors and drawers. We accept both kitchen and bathroom cabinets in sets or individual pieces. Pieces must have no structural or water damage.</p>
<p>Doors must be in excellent condition, with no rotted wood, broken glass, or peeling paint.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Pre-hung or slabs •Exterior or Interior •Storm doors must have all tracking
<p>Windows must be complete units (with all sashes and frame) with no rotted wood, cracked or foggy glass.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> •No wood or aluminum single pane windows
<p>Lighting must be complete and in excellent condition.</p>
<p>Plumbing items must be in excellent condition with no chips, cracks, or rust.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Stainless steel and porcelain kitchen sinks •Pedestal and drop-in bathroom sinks •Fiberglass bathtubs with no cracks •Complete faucets
<p>Architectural Items – We accept mantels, columns, stained, and leaded glass windows, etc.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Flooring</p> <p>Carpet must be 10ft. x 10ft. or larger and new, with no visible wear or tear, stains, or animal smells. Carpet Padding must be at least 5ft. by 5ft. and new, with no stains or animal smells. Hardwood flooring with no splitting or cracking, must be at least 25 square feet. Vinyl and ceramic tile must be at least 25 square feet and in excellent condition.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Hardware</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Complete sets of door hardware, hinges, etc. •Any quantity of nails, screws, fasteners, hangers, connectors, etc.
<p style="text-align: center;">Paint</p> <p>Full, unopened non-rusted cans of <i>latex</i> paint only.</p>
<p>Lumber must be at least 5 ft. in length, with no nails or warping. Sheet goods (particle board, plywood, and paneling) must be at least full sheets with no damage. Trim and molding must be at least 5 ft. in length.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Electrical</p> <p>Residential and commercial items are accepted.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Miscellaneous</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Wallpaper • Gas logs •Free standing wood stoves •Shutters •Window AC units (under 5 years old) • Brick/Block •Hand and power tools (in perfect working condition) •Glass shower doors
